Macmillan's response has been to acknowledge this pluralism, increasingly incorporating examples from diverse English-speaking communities, though the core grammar remains anchored in a neutral, professional register. This balancing act reflects a broader industry struggle: how to serve global communication needs without erasing local linguistic authenticity. Expert perspectives on *Macmillan English Grammar in Context* reveal its dual role as both educational tool and cultural artifact. Language pedagogues such as Dr. Catherine Walter of the University of Oxford emphasize that its strength lies in its contextual authenticity: “It doesn't just teach rules—it shows why those rules matter in real communication.
