The local gun market, tightly interwoven with rural identity and tourism (e.g., hunting and shooting tourism), resisted early resistance not out of ideological purism, but because many users viewed training as practical, not political. The test's economic impact is subtle but profound. Training centers reporting increased demand cite a growing awareness of liability and competence. Controversies and Resistance: Liberty, Skepticism, and Political Fault Lines

The GSP Test MN has not escaped ideological opposition. Critics, particularly within gun rights advocacy circles, frame mandatory training as an infringement on Second Amendment rights. The American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU) has challenged similar mandates in other states, citing overreach and lack of due process.
